6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to litter control on state land."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 11.20.590(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) No person may put or throw any kind of garbage, rubbish,  
10 or material, or abandon animal viscera or other discarded objects  
11 on a highway, highway right-of-way, [OR] public recreation facility,  
12 or other state land. No person may put or throw any kind of litter  
13 or trash from a highway or highway right-of-way onto private property  
14 or state land.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 11.20.590(e) is amended to read:

16 (e) A court entering a judgment of conviction and imposing a  
17 sentence for violation of (b) of this section may suspend the sentence  
18 and place the defendant on probation under the provisions of AS 12.55.-  
19 080 - 12.55.100. The defendant may be required, as a condition of  
20 probation, to pick up garbage and rubbish from the nearest highway,  
21 highway right-of-way, [OR] public recreation facility, or other state  
22 land for not more than four hours a day on each of two days.

23 \* Sec. 3. AS 11.20.590(f) is amended to read:

24 (f) "Highway" means all highways (whether included in primary  
25 or secondary systems), roads, road rights-of-way, streets, trails,  
26 walks, bridges, tunnels, drainage structures, and other similar or  
27 related structures or facilities, and further includes ferries and  
28 all such related facilities. "State land" means all land, including  
29 shore, tide and submerged lands, or resources belonging to or acquired
