6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to litter control on state land."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.20.590(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) No person may put or throw any kind of garbage, rubbish,
10 or material, or abandon animal viscera or other discarded objects
11 on a highway, highway right-of-way, or public recreation facility,
12 and, except in specially designated garbage disposal areas provided for
13 by law, no person may put or throw any kind of garbage, rubbish or other
14 discarded objects on other state land. No person may put or throw any
15 kind of litter or trash from a highway or highway right-of-way onto
16 private property or state land, except in specially designated garbage
17 disposal areas provided for by law.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 11.20.590(e) is amended to read:

19 (e) A court entering a judgment of conviction and imposing a
20 sentence for violation of (b) of this section may suspend the sentence
21 and place the defendant on probation under the provisions of AS 12.55.-
22 080 - 12.55.100. The defendant may be required, as a condition of
23 probation, to pick up garbage and rubbish from the nearest highway,
24 highway right-of-way, [OR] public recreation facility, or other state
25 land for not more than four hours a day on each of two days.

27 (f) "Highway" means all highways (whether included in primary
28 or secondary systems), roads, road rights-of-way, streets, trails,
29 walks, bridges, tunnels, drainage structures, and other similar or

1 related structures or facilities, and further includes ferries and
2 all such related facilities. "State land" means all land, including
3 shore, tide and submerged lands, or resources belonging to or acquired
4 by the state.
