6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to restrictions on issuance of liquor
7 licenses."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.15.020(e) is amended to read:

10 (e) Churches and schools. The board shall not issue a beverage
11 dispensary license or package liquor store license for the sale of intoxicating
12 liquor in any building in which the public entrance is within
13 200 feet of a school ground or church building measured by the shortest
14 pedestrian route from the outer boundaries of the school ground or
15 public entrance of a church building in which religious services are
16 conducted, within or outside any corporate municipality [NOR FOR USE
17 WITHIN ONE MILE OF A STATE-OWNED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY WHERE DORMI-
18 TORIES ARE PROVIDED. THIS DISTANCE SHALL BE MEASURED IN A STRAIGHT
19 LINE FROM THE CENTRAL ADMINISTRATIVE BUILDING OF THE COLLEGE OR UNI-
20 VERSITY]. A license may be reissued or transferred from one licensee
21 to another, for the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building in which
22 that sale was authorized by law on April 25, 1960. When a license for
23 the sale of intoxicating liquor in a building within 200 feet of a
24 school ground or church building in which religious services are
25 conducted is forfeited, lapses or is transferred to other premises,
26 no license for the sale of intoxicating liquor at the prior licensed
27 location shall thereafter be issued. However, the location may be re-
28 licensed in the event of the removal of either cause of the restriction.
