6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the penalties for driving a motor  
7 vehicle while under the influence of intoxicating  
8 liquor or drugs."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 28.35.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 28.35.030. DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING  
12 LIQUOR OR DRUGS. A person who, while under the influence of intoxi-  
13 cating liquor or narcotic drugs, operates or drives an automobile,  
14 motorcycle or other motor vehicle in the state upon conviction is  
15 punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for  
16 not more than one year, or by both. In the case of a first offense  
17 his punishment shall include at least two days imprisonment, and in  
18 the case of subsequent offenses his punishment shall include at least  
19 10 days imprisonment. Upon conviction for a second or subsequent  
20 offense in violation of this section, the offender's license, and his  
21 right to obtain a license, to operate a motor vehicle shall be sus-  
22 pended for a period of three years, and this suspension is in addition  
23 to any other punishment fixed by the court.
