For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liquor identification cards."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 04.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 04.15.063. LIQUOR IDENTIFICATION CARD. Upon reaching the  
10 age of 19, a person may apply to the department for a nontransferable  
11 liquor identification card. In addition to the requirements of  
12 sec. 65 of this chapter, the department shall provide by regulation  
13 for the issuance of the card specified in this section, including but  
14 not limited to a fee for issuance, the format of the card, and the  
15 procedure for issuance.

Sec. 04.15.065. DRIVER'S LICENSE AS PROOF OF AGE. A valid  
18 Alaska driver's license or a liquor identification card issued under  
19 sec. 63 of this chapter is acceptable as proof of age when used for  
20 identification in the purchase of liquor and for presence in estab-  
21 lishments where liquor is sold if the license or identification card  
22 is made of or encased in plastic and contains a photograph of the  
23 license holder and a statement of his age or date of birth. The  
24 liquor licensee may not be held liable for any of the penalties  
25 imposed for serving minors or permitting minors on the premises when  
26 such a driver's license or identification card indicates that the  
27 owner and possessor of the license is 19 years of age or over.
