IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SEVENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of firearms."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 11.55.050 is amended to read:

Sec. 11.55.050. FLOURISHING, POINTING OR DISCHARGING FIREARM IN PUBLIC PLACE. Unless specifically permitted by law, a [A] person who flourishes, points or discharges a firearm in a city of any class, [TOWN, VILLAGE OR OTHER COMMUNITY] or in or on a railway coach, steamboat or steamship, or in or near a park or public grounds, or at a public place, whether public in itself, or made public at the time by an assemblage of persons, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment in a jail for not more than six months, or by both.
