6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of firearms."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 11.55.050 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.55.050. FLOURISHING, POINTING OR DISCHARGING FIREARM IN  
10 PUBLIC PLACE. Unless specifically permitted by law or ordinance, a  
11 [A] person who flourishes, points or discharges a firearm in a city  
12 of any class, [TOWN, VILLAGE OR OTHER COMMUNITY,] or in or on a  
13 railway coach, steamboat or steamship, or in or near a park or public  
14 grounds, or at a public place, whether public in itself, or made  
15 public at the time by an assemblage of persons, is guilty of a  
16 misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more  
17 than \$500, or by imprisonment in a jail for not more than six months,  
18 or by both.
