\* Section 1. AS 16.05.660 is amended to read:

Sec. 16.05.660. LICENSE EXEMPTION. A person may, by complying

11

with the 25-cent license requirement of sec. 340 of this chapter,

12

take, barter, or sell not more than 2,000 pounds each of tom cod,

13

blue cod, smelt, pickerel, white fish, crab, pike, lush, sheefish and

14

salmon by-products, including salmon skins, heads, entrails, roe,

15

and dried salmon [AND SPIDER CRAB] a year from waters of the state.
