For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to revenue sharing with local govern-
ments; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 43.18.010(h) and (i) are repealed and re-enacted to read:

(h) During each fiscal year the state shall make payments as follows:

(1) \$1,000 per hospital bed to an organized borough or a city outside an organized borough in which a hospital is operated for each hospital bed actually used for patient care, limited to the number of beds provided for in the construction design of the hospital, or \$50,000 per hospital as the local government may determine;

(2) \$1,000 per hospital bed to hospitals located outside any organized municipality for each hospital bed actually used for patient care, limited to the number of beds provided for in the construction design of the hospital, or \$50,000, as the hospital may determine;

(3) \$1,000 per bed to an organized borough or city outside an organized borough in which a health facility is operated for each bed actually used for patient care, limited to the number of beds provided for in the construction design of the health facility, or \$4,000 per health facility as the local government may determine;

(4) funds received by a local government under (1), (2) or (3) of this subsection shall be used for expenses of operation, maintenance, or health services or facilities, as the local government or hospital outside an organized municipality determines.

1 (5) Prior to distribution of funds hereunder, the Commissioner
2 of Health and Social Services must certify to the disbursing agency that
3 the recipient hospital or health facility has incurred in the prior
4 year no expenses for rent, supplies, services or otherwise, which exceed
5 the fair market or reasonable value thereof; and further, that any
6 accumulation of assets by non-profit corporations or other recipients
7 hereunder are dedicated irrevocably to a public purpose.

8 (i) In (h) of this section

9 (1) "hospital" means a licensed hospital determined by the
10 Department of Health and Social Services to be a general hospital; the
11 term excludes facilities operated or wholly supported by the state or
12 the federal government;

13 (2) "health facility" means public health centers, maternity
14 homes and community mental health centers, facilities for the mentally
15 or physically handicapped, nursing homes and convalescent centers
16 which are licensed, when required, by the state under AS 18.20.010 -
17 18.20.130 and are owned or operated or both by a local government or
18 by a nonprofit corporation or other nonprofit sponsor; the term excludes
19 facilities operated or wholly supported by the state or the federal
20 government.

21 * Section 2. AS 43.18.040. REGULATIONS. The Local Affairs Agency
22 shall adopt regulations necessary or desirable for carrying out the
23 purposes of this chapter.

24 * Section 3. AS 43.18.050. A municipality must expend state assistance
25 received under this chapter on those specific municipal services for which
26 the state assistance was received.

27 * Section 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1972.
