6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to insurance required by air carriers."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 02.05.130(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) Except as provided in (d) of this section no [NO] certificate
10 may be issued to a person to operate as an air carrier within the
11 state and no certificated carrier may operate within the state unless
12 the person or carrier has procured and kept in force a reasonable
13 security required by the commission for the protection of the public
14 against damage and injury for which the carrier may be liable by
15 reason of its operation as an air carrier.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 02.05.130 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

17 (d) The minimum amount of security required under (a) of this
18 section for bodily injury to or death of one passenger is \$200,000.

19 * Sec. 3. It is the purpose of this Act to annul the provision of
20 3AAC, sec. 3782(1).
