6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driving while under the influence  
7 of intoxicating liquor, narcotic drugs or depressant,  
8 hallucinogenic or stimulant drugs."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 28.35.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 28.35.030. DRIVING WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF INTOXICATING  
12 LIQUOR OR DRUGS. A person who, while under the influence of intoxi-  
13 cating liquor, [OR] narcotic drugs or depressant, hallucinogenic or  
14 stimulating drugs as defined in AS 17.12.150, operates or drives  
15 an automobile, motorcycle or other motor vehicle in the state upon  
16 conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or by  
17 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both. Upon conviction  
18 for a second or subsequent offense in violation of this section, the  
19 offender's license, and his right to obtain a license, to operate a  
20 motor vehicle shall be suspended for a period of three years, and  
21 this suspension is in addition to any other punishment fixed by the  
22 court.
