For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teachers' leaves of absence."

7

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 14.20.345 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

9

(d) The governing body of the district may agree to continue

10

the teacher's retirement contributions if the teacher agrees to pay

11

the required seven per cent of the salary he would have received

12

during his leave of absence and reimburse the district for the dis-

13

trict's required retirement contribution. Each year of leave of absence

14

then would count as a year of retirement service.

15

(e) The governing body of the district may advance the teacher

16

on the district salary schedule when he returns to employment if the

17

governing body determines that the teacher's leave of absence was

18

educationally or professionally beneficial to the teacher or the

19

district.
