6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to notice of accident involving
7 motor vehicles; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.35.080(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting
11 in bodily injury to or death of a person or total property damage to
12 an apparent extent of \$300 [\$100] or more shall immediately by the
13 quickest means of communication give notice of the accident to the
14 local police department if the accident occurs within a municipality,
15 otherwise to the Department of Public Safety.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 28.35.080(b) is amended to read:

17 (b) The driver of a vehicle involved in an accident resulting
18 in bodily injury to or death of a person or total property damage to
19 an apparent extent of \$300 [\$100] or more shall, within two days
20 after the accident, forward a written report of the accident to the
21 Department of Public Safety and to the local police department if
22 the accident occurs within a municipality.

23 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approv-
24 al or on the day it becomes law without approval.
