8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.15.170(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) The supreme court [PRESIDING JUDGE OF THE SUPERIOR COURT IN  
11 EACH JUDICIAL DISTRICT] shall appoint the magistrates for the district  
12 court for each [THE] judicial district. Each magistrate serves at the  
13 pleasure of the supreme [SUPERIOR] court [IN THE JUDICIAL DISTRICT FOR  
14 WHICH APPOINTED].

16 Sec. 22.15.190. ASSIGNMENT OF DISTRICT JUDGES AND MAGISTRATES.  
17 Each district judge [AND EACH MAGISTRATE] shall hold court at such times  
18 and places as are assigned by the presiding judge of the superior court  
19 of his district; each magistrate shall hold court at the times and  
20 places assigned by the supreme court. The presiding judge in any  
21 judicial district may assign any district judge [OR MAGISTRATE] within  
22 his district to serve temporarily in any other judicial districts; the  
23 supreme court may assign any magistrate to serve temporarily in any  
24 other judicial districts. Rules and procedures for temporary assignment  
25 including the emergency situation where a superior court judge is not  
26 readily available to assign a district judge [OR MAGISTRATE] shall be  
27 as prescribed by the supreme court.
