6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Legislative Council.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 24.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 24.20.145. INDEPENDENT AUDIT. (a) The Legislative Council
10 shall, each January and July, cause an audit to be performed of all
11 expenditures by the Legislative Affairs Agency on behalf of the
12 legislature, the Legislative Council, and the permanent legislative
13 staff. A complete report of all expenditures each six-month period,
14 together with an explanation of the purpose of the expenditure, shall
15 be furnished all members of the legislature on or before January 31
16 and July 31 of each year.

17 (b) The audits required by (a) of this section shall be performed
18 by an independent firm or person.
