6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a period of probation for state
7 employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25.150(7) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (7) a period of probation not to exceed one year before an
11 appointment to a position becomes permanent, except that an employee
12 receiving a promotional appointment shall retain permanent status in
13 his prior position during the period of probation if at the time of
14 the promotional appointment he held permanent status in the position
15 from which he was appointed.
