6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a period of probation for state
7 employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.25.150(7) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (7) a period of probation not to exceed one year before an
11 appointment to a position becomes permanent, except that a permanent
12 employee receiving a promotional appointment shall retain permanent
13 status in the service and the job class from which appointed for the
14 duration of the probationary period, and may be demoted to his former
15 class without right of appeal, sec. 170 of this chapter notwithstanding,
16 but if dismissed from the service he shall have appeal rights under
17 sec. 170 of this chapter;
