5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to certain rules of the road."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.05.030 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (c) Notwithstanding the authority granted the commissioner in
10 (a) of this section, no regulation may be promulgated (1) to prevent
11 vehicle traffic facing a steady red signal to proceed, after stopping,
12 to make a right turn from a one-way or two-way roadway into a two-way
13 roadway or into a one-way roadway carrying traffic in the direction
14 of the right turn, or (2) to set the legal speed limit on divided
15 four lane limited or controlled access state highways less than 70
16 miles an hour, except within the corporate limits of a city or in
17 other areas of congestion where traffic control devices are utilized.
18 If the commissioner proposes regulations under the authority of this
19 section, they shall be submitted to the presiding officer of each
20 house on the day the house convenes, together with written justification
21 for the proposals. The legislature has 60 days of a regular session,
22 or a full session if of shorter duration to disapprove the proposed
23 regulations. Unless disapproved by a special concurrent resolution
24 introduced in either house, concurred in by a majority of the members
25 in each house, the regulations become effective at a date to be desig-
26 nated by the department.
