For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the public employees retirement  
7 system; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10

Sec. 39.35.675. NORMAL RETIREMENT DATE FOR CERTAIN NATIONAL

11

GUARD EMPLOYEES. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in this

12

chapter the "normal retirement date" for a civilian employee of the

13

Alaska National Guard is the first day of the month after he reaches

14

the National Guard mandatory retirement age with eight years of

15

credited service.

16

\* Sec. 2. For purposes of eligibility for normal retirement benefits

17

this Act is retrospective and applies to civilian employees terminating

18

employment with the Alaska National Guard on or after August 1, 1968.

19

However, this Act is prospective for all other purposes, including the pay-

20

ment of retirement benefits.

21

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approv-

22

al or on the day it becomes law without approval.
