6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legislative salaries, additional
7 allowances and per diem; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 24.15.010 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 24.15.010. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. The rate of per diem
12 instead of subsistence for each member of the legislature is \$25 [\$35]
13 for the first 62 days [EACH DAY] of a legislative session. The per
14 diem is also payable for those days of necessary travel to and from
15 sessions.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 24.15.020 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 24.15.020. ANNUAL LEGISLATIVE SALARIES. The annual salary
18 for each member of the legislature is \$3,000 [\$9,000] to be paid in
19 approximately equal monthly payments. The president of the senate
20 and speaker of the house of representatives are each entitled to an
21 additional \$500 a year during tenure of office.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 24.15.030 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 24.15.030. ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCES. In addition, each member
24 of the legislature is entitled to an annual allowance of \$125 [\$4,000]
25 for postage, stationery, stenographic services and other expenses.

26 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1972.
