5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the public employees retirement
7 system of Alaska."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 39.35.154. ASSOCIATE MEMBERS. (a) Notwithstanding any
11 other provision of this chapter, the designer of the state flag, state
12 seal, state medal for heroism, the composer of the score and the
13 author of the lyrics of the state song, and the author of the state
14 motto are eligible associate members of the public employees retirement
15 system of Alaska if their literary work or artistic design was selected
16 in a statewide competition.

17 (b) The benefits received by associate members under this section
18 are neither divisible by will nor descendable under the law of intestate
19 descent. The benefits may be enjoyed solely by the associate member
20 named in (a) of this section during his lifetime and shall be at least,
21 but in no event more than, \$750 a month.

22 (c) In order to receive the benefits prescribed in (b) of this
23 section the associate member must meet the minimum eligibility require-
24 ments as to age required by this chapter.
