6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to regular sessions of the legis-
7 lature."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 24.05.090 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 24.05.090. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene
11 at the capital each year on the second Monday in January at 10:00 a.m.
12 Pacific Standard Time. Each legislature shall have a duration of two
13 years and shall consist of a "First Regular Session" which shall meet
14 in the odd-numbered years and a "Second Regular Session" which shall
15 meet in the even-numbered years and any special session or sessions
16 which the governor or legislature may find necessary to call. Regular
17 sessions are limited to ninety days.
