6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Welding Examiners."  
7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 08.99.030 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 08.99.030. SOURCE OF APPOINTMENTS. The governor shall  
10 appoint board members from a list of persons prepared by the [ALASKA  
11 CHAPTER OF THE AMERICAN WELDING SOCIETY AND THE] Alaska Society of  
12 Professional Engineers and submitted at least 30 days before the ex-  
13 piration of a term and not more than 60 days after a vacancy occurs in  
14 an unexpired term. The list shall contain not less than two recom-  
15 mended candidates for each appointment. The governor shall make  
16 appointments within 30 days after receiving the list.

18 Sec. 08.99.050. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS. Each member of  
19 the board shall be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the  
20 state. At least three members shall be persons with engineering  
21 degrees or registration as an engineer and each engineer member shall  
22 have at least five years engineering experience. At least two members  
23 shall be welders with at least five years experience and at least one  
24 member shall be a mechanical contractor with at least five years ex-  
25 perience. When possible the board shall include at least one member  
26 from each judicial district, with the remaining members chosen from the  
27 state at large. All members shall have extensive experience in welding.
