6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to meat inspection."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 03.05.020(1) is amended to read:

9 (1) require routine inspection[,AT STATE EXPENSE,]of food  
10 animals [LIVESTOCK] and poultry and derivative food products, to  
11 protect the public against fraud, disease and spoilage, and in this  
12 connection he shall promulgate uniform [RULES AND] regulations  
13 establishing standards of identity and composition of these food  
14 products and minimum standards of sanitation and handling methods as  
15 to all phases of slaughtering, processing, storing, [AND] transporting,  
16 displaying and selling of these food products;

18 Sec. 03.05.040. INSPECTION. On any business day during the  
19 usual hours of business the commissioner or his authorized inspector  
20 may, for the purpose of inspecting agricultural products subject to  
21 regulation, enter a storehouse, warehouse, cold storage plant, packing  
22 house, slaughterhouse, retail store or other building or place where  
23 those products are kept, [OR] stored, processed or sold.
