6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to mobile home standards."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 45.30.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 Sec. 45.30.010. MOBILE HOME STANDARDS. (a) The Department of
10 Commerce shall, by regulations adopted under the Administrative Proce-
11 dure Act (AS 44.62), set minimum mobile home standards for the state at
12 least as stringent as those set out in the American National Standards
13 Institute Code A119.1 - 1969 for mobile homes. The department may
14 adopt that code by reference, specifying appropriate modifications, if
15 any, of it.

16 (b) The regulations adopted under (a) of this section apply to
17 all mobile homes constructed in the state and to new and used mobile
18 homes brought into the state after the effective date of this Act.
19 They do not apply to campers, motor homes, or vehicular, portable
20 structures with the dimensions of 35 feet in length and 8 feet in width,
21 or less.

22 * Sec. 2. AS 45.30.030(b) is amended to read:

23 (b) The department is responsible for inspecting mobile homes
24 constructed in the state and new and used mobile homes coming into the
25 state after September 1, 1971. A mobile home which meets the specifi-
26 cation of the regulations adopted under sec. 10 of this chapter [CODE]
27 shall have affixed to it a state inspection tag stating that it meets
28 state requirements. The cost of the tag is \$10 and shall be paid by
29 the manufacturer or owner of the mobile home to the department.

1 * Sec. 3. AS 45.30.040 is amended to read:

2 Sec. 45.30.040. ENFORCEMENT OF COMPLIANCE. A department inspector
3 shall give written notice to the owner of a mobile home of each viola-
4 tion of the regulations adopted under sec. 10 of this chapter [CODE].

5 The notice of violation shall accurately describe the violation and
6 give specific reference to the section and paragraph of the regulations
7 [CODE].

8 * Sec. 4. AS 45.30.050 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 45.30.050. PENALTY. A person who violates a provision of the
10 regulations adopted under sec. 10 of this chapter [CODE], and who,
11 after receiving the notification required by sec. 40 of this chapter,
12 refuses or fails to correct the violation, is guilty of a misdemeanor
13 and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000.
14 Each mobile home constructed or brought into the state in violation of
15 those regulations [THIS CHAPTER] is a separate violation [OF THIS
16 CHAPTER].

17 * Sec. 5. AS 45.30.020, 45.30.030(a), and 45.30.060(1) and (2) are
18 repealed.
