6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the chief school administrator."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.20.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 14.20.010. TEACHER CERTIFICATE REQUIRED. A person may not
10 be employed as a teacher in the public schools of the state unless he
11 possesses a valid teacher certificate; however, a person employed as
12 the chief school administrator for a school district under AS 14.14.130
13 is exempt from this requirement.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 14.20.207(1) is amended to read:

15 (1) "teacher" means a person serving in a teaching, coun-
16 seling, or administrative capacity and required to be certificated in
17 order to hold the position; however, the chief school administrator
18 for a school district is not required to be certificated;
