6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Regents of the
7 University of Alaska."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.40.140 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.40.140. TERM OF OFFICE. The term of office of a regent
11 is eight years. The term of office begins on the first Monday in
12 February of the year in which the appointment is made. Each regent
13 serves until his successor is appointed and qualifies. No regent may
14 serve more than one full eight-year term; if a regent is appointed
15 to fill an unexpired term, he may complete that term and be reappointed
16 to a second eight-year term. A regent who has completed a full eight-
17 year term may not be reappointed to the board until one year has
18 elapsed. No regent may serve more than two consecutive years as
19 president of the board.
