6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the meetings of the Board of
7 Regents of the University of Alaska; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 14.40.160 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 Sec. 14.40.160. BOARD MEETINGS PUBLIC, MEETING NOTICE, PUBLIC
12 FACILITIES. (a) The provisions of AS 44.62.310 apply to meetings of
13 the Board of Regents. All meetings of the board, its committees or
14 subcommittees, are open to the public and press except as otherwise
15 provided in AS 44.62.310(c). The findings of an executive session shall
16 be made a part of the record of the proceedings of the Board of
17 Regents. All records of the meetings and proceedings shall be open
18 to inspection by the public and the press at reasonable times.

19 (b) The board may determine the time and place of its meetings.
20 However, 30 days notice is required for all regular meetings and 10 days
21 notice is required for special meetings of the board, its committees or
22 subcommittees called under the bylaws or rules of procedure of the
23 board.

24 (c) The Board of Regents shall provide adequate facilities for
25 members of the public to attend the meetings of the board, its commit-
26 tees or subcommittees.

27 * Sec. 2. AS 44.62.310(a) is amended to read:

28 (a) All meetings of a board of regents or of an administrative
29 body, board, commission, committee, subcommittee, authority, council,

1 agency, or other organization, including subordinate units of the above
2 groups, of the state or any of its political subdivisions, including
3 but not limited to municipalities, boroughs, school boards, and all
4 other boards, agencies, assemblies, councils, departments, divisions,
5 bureaus, commissions or organizations, advisory or otherwise, of the
6 state or local government supported in whole or in part by public
7 money or authorized to spend public money, are open to the public ex-
8 cept as otherwise provided by this section.

9 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
10 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
