6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to disclosure of financial interests
7 by constitutional convention delegates."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (c) The supreme court has original jurisdiction in an action
11 brought by a qualified Alaskan voter to compel enforcement of AS 15.-
12 50.095.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 15.50 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 Sec. 15.50.095. DELEGATES' REPORT OF FINANCIAL INTERESTS. (a)
15 Each person elected as a delegate to the constitutional convention shall
16 file with the administrative director of courts, no later than 30 days
17 after his election the following report of his personal financial
18 interests:

19 (1) the amount or value and source of each fee or compensa-
20 tion of \$2,000 or more received by him, or his spouse or his minor
21 child who lives with him, during the preceding calendar year from a
22 client;

23 (2) the name and address of each business or professional
24 corporation, firm, or enterprise in which he, or his spouse or his
25 minor child who lives with him, was an officer, director, partner,
26 proprietor, or employee who received compensation of \$2,000 or more
27 during the preceding calendar year;

28 (3) the identity of each interest in real or personal
29 property, including securities, having a value of \$5,000 or more which

1 he, or his spouse or his minor child who lives with him, owned at any
2 time during the preceding calendar year;

3 (4) the identity of each trust or other fiduciary relation
4 in which he, or his spouse or his minor child who lives with him, held
5 a beneficial interest having a value of \$5,000 or more, and the identity,
6 if known, of each interest in the trust or other fiduciary relation in
7 real or personal property in which the delegate, or his spouse or his
8 minor child who lives with him, held a beneficial interest having a
9 value of \$5,000 or more, at any time during the preceding calendar
10 year; if he cannot obtain the identity of the fiduciary interests, he
11 shall request the fiduciary to report that information to the adminis-
12 trative director in the same manner that reports are filed under this
13 section;

14 (5) the identity of each liability of \$5,000 or more owed
15 by him, or by him and his spouse jointly, at any time during the pre-
16 ceding calendar year;

17 (6) the source and value of all gifts in the aggregate value
18 of \$100 or more from any single source received by him during the
19 preceding calendar year, except one received from his spouse, child or
20 parent;

21 (7) a listing of all contracts and offers to contract with
22 the state government held, by him or his spouse or his minor child who
23 lives with him, during the preceding calendar year; and

24 (8) any other information on an interest which he considers
25 a potential source of conflict with his duties as a delegate.

26 (b) Reports filed under (a) of this section shall be kept by the
27 administrative director for at least three years and shall be made
28 available promptly for public inspection and copying.

29 (c) The administrative director shall prepare and keep available

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for distribution forms on which the reports required by (a) of this section may be filed.

(d) A delegate whose spouse refuses to furnish the information required by (a) of this section pertaining to the spouse shall file a statement to that effect at the time he files his report.

(e) A delegate who fails to file the report required by (a) of this section within 30 days after it is due is not entitled to his salary or per diem or travel allowances, and may not be paid for any service nor reimbursed or paid for any travel after the 30th day until he files the report. The office of a delegate who fails to file the report within 60 days after it is due automatically becomes vacant at the end of the 60th day.
