6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to information on oil and gas wells;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 31.05.030(d)(2) is amended to read:

10 (2) the making and filing of [REPORTS,] well logs, drilling  
11 logs, electric logs, lithologic logs, directional surveys, and reports  
12 containing [ALL OTHER] subsurface information acquired in the course of  
13 drilling, studying, or operating [ON] a well drilled for oil or gas,  
14 or for the discovery of oil or gas, or for geologic information and the  
15 department shall, by regulation, specify the period within which  
16 specific logs or reports required under this paragraph shall be made  
17 and submitted and those logs or reports submitted bearing the word  
18 "confidential" shall be kept confidential until 24 months after the  
19 date on which the well to which the log or report refers has been  
20 completed, abandoned or suspended, except that reports of well location,  
21 depth, status, and production shall not be classified as confidential  
22 [, AND THE REQUIRED REPORTS AND INFORMATION SHALL BE FILED WITHIN 30  
23 DAYS AFTER THE COMPLETION, ABANDONMENT, OR SUSPENSION OF THE WELL];

24 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
25 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
