5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the relocation of the capital
7 from Juneau to the southcentral area."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. There shall be placed on the ballot at the next general
10 election the question:

11 "Shall the capital of the state be moved from Juneau to a more
12 central and accessible location in the State? YES [] NO []"

13 * Sec. 2. If the referendum provided in sec. 1 is adopted, the governor
14 shall appoint a capital relocation commission consisting of one person from
15 each senatorial district. The commission shall make recommendations to the
16 First Session of the Eighth Legislature for the location of the state capital
17 as provided by the referendum including a discussion of no less than three
18 alternative sites. The legislature shall designate the most appropriate
19 site from among the recommendations of the commission.
