5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$36,000,000 for the purpose
8 of providing assistance to local governments in paying
9 the cost of construction and capital improvements for
10 river and harbor development in the form of flood con-
11 trol and small boat harbor projects; and providing for
12 an effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 * Section 1. For the purpose of providing assistance to local govern-
15 ments in paying the cost of construction and capital improvements for river
16 and harbor development in the form of flood control and small boat harbor
17 projects, general obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of
18 not more than \$36,000,000 shall be issued and sold. The full faith, credit
19 and resources of the state are pledged to the payment of the principal and
20 interest on these bonds. These bonds shall be issued under the provisions
21 of AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the time of issuance.

22 * Sec. 2. The amounts of these bonds and the time of their issuance
23 shall be determined by the governor in accordance with the following schedule:

28 * Sec. 3. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
29 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1972

1 River and Harbor Project Construction Fund" shall be established, to which
2 shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of the bonds described in sec. 1
3 of this Act except for the accrued interest and premiums. There is appro-
4 priated from the "1972 River and Harbor Project Construction Fund" to the
5 Department of Public Works the sum of \$36,000,000.

6 * Sec. 4. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
7 voters of the state, the amount of \$126,000 or as much of that amount as is
8 found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
9 state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay the
10 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
11 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this section
12 shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale of the
13 bonds authorized by this Act.

14 * Sec. 5. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to
15 be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the
16 next state general election and shall read substantially as follows:

17 Proposition

18 State General Obligation River and Harbor
19 Project Construction Bonds \$36,000,000

20 Shall the State of Alaska issue its general obligation bonds
21 in the principal amount of not more than \$36,000,000 for the
22 purpose of providing assistance to local governments in
23 paying the cost of river and harbor development projects?
