6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to applications for employment."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 23.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 23.10.039. ARREST, INDICTMENT AND CONVICTION FOR PURPOSES  
10 OF APPLICATION FOR EMPLOYMENT. (a) For the purpose of making applica-  
11 tion for employment, a person is not considered to have been arrested  
12 or indicted for any offense under the laws of Alaska, another state or  
13 the United States if the arrest or indictment did not result in a con-  
14 viction for that offense.

15 (b) For the purpose of making application for employment, a  
16 person is not considered to have been arrested, indicted or convicted  
17 under the laws of Alaska, another state or the United States of

18 (1) a misdemeanor if two years have elapsed from the date of

19 (A) his unconditional release from imprisonment,  
20 or

21 (B) the completion of the terms of his sentence,  
22 including probation or parole, or

23 (2) a felony if five years have elapsed from the date of

24 (A) his unconditional release from imprisonment, or  
25 (B) the completion of the terms of his sentence,  
26 including probation or parole.
