6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to minority culture education; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17.051 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (c) A district that provides a program in minority culture
11 education approved by the department is entitled to an amount not to
12 exceed two per cent of its total foundation support received under
13 the provisions of this chapter.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.250 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

15 (19) "minority culture education" means substantial instruc-
16 tional programs in minority language, traditions, arts, crafts, history
17 and other culturally related subjects.

18 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1972.
