6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liquor licenses."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 04.10.070 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 04.10.070. CLUB LICENSE. (a) A club license gives to  
10 clubs, fraternal organizations, and patriotic organizations, that have  
11 a state or national charter, and that have been so incorporated and  
12 active for a period of two years or more, the right to sell intoxi-  
13 cating liquors to members and their guests [FAMILIES] only in their  
14 club rooms. The club license fee is \$400, except that where any  
15 club has certified to the board that the gross sales of intoxicating  
16 liquor for the preceding year were less than \$5,000 the club license  
17 fee is \$200.

18 (b) A club license created by this section may not be held by  
19 a club, fraternal organization, or patriotic organization which denies  
20 services to a guest of a member or otherwise discriminates against a  
21 guest of a member because of race, color or national origin.

22 (c) An organization holding a club license under this section  
23 which has activities on the licensed premises from time to time which  
24 are open to the public must, for the purposes of this section, treat  
25 each member of the invited public as a guest of a member of the club  
26 or refrain from dispensing intoxicating liquors to anyone for the  
27 duration of the public activity.
