6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of electrical
7 contractors; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.40 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 08.40.190. CEASE AND DESIST ORDER. (a) If the commissioner
11 of labor determines that a person is acting as an electrical contractor
12 in violation of this chapter, he may issue a cease and desist order
13 prohibiting further action by the person as an electrical contractor.
14 The cease and desist order remains in effect until the person has
15 submitted evidence acceptable to the commissioner of labor showing that
16 the violation has been corrected.

17 (b) A person affected by an order issued pursuant to (a) of this
18 section may seek equitable relief preventing the commissioner of labor
19 from enforcing the order.

20 Sec. 08.40.200. INJUNCTIVE RELIEF. The commissioner of labor
21 may seek an injunction in the superior court to enjoin a person from
22 violating this chapter.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
24 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
