7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 08.64.200(2) is amended to read:

9 (2) submit a certificate of graduation from a legally chart-  
10 ered medical school accredited by the Association of American Medical  
11 Colleges and the Council on Medical Education of the American Medical  
12 Association [WHOSE REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION WERE AT THE TIME OF  
13 GRADUATION NOT LESS THAN THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ASSOCIATION OF  
14 AMERICAN MEDICAL COLLEGES];

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.64.270(a) is amended to read:

16 (a) The board may issue a nonrenewable temporary permit to an  
17 applicant for licensure by endorsement or by examination who meets the  
18 requirements of sec. 200 or 205 of this chapter and pays the required  
19 fee.

20 \* Sec. 3. AS 08.64.270(c) is amended to read:

21 (c) A temporary permit issued to an applicant for licensure by  
22 examination is valid [FOR EIGHT MONTHS OR] until the results of the  
23 first examination for which the applicant is scheduled are published  
24 [, WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST]. If the applicant fails to take the first  
25 examination for which he is scheduled his temporary permit is revoked  
26 on the day of the examination.
