6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to intoxicating liquor."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 04.15.020(g) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 (g) The governing body of a political subdivision of the state  
10 may provide by ordinance that the provisions of (c) of this section  
11 do not apply in the political subdivision when elections are being  
12 held. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall adopt regulations  
13 governing the sale of intoxicating liquor on election days in the  
14 unorganized areas of the state.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 04.10.430 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (c) Notwithstanding the preference provisions of (a) of this  
17 section, if the petition for a local option election is for a community  
18 liquor license under sec. 139 of this chapter, the board is precluded  
19 from issuing any other type of license within the boundaries, or within  
20 five miles of the boundaries, of the city or town opting for the com-  
21 munity liquor license.
