6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to intoxicating liquor."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 04.15.020(g) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

9 (g) The governing body of a political subdivision of the state
10 may provide by ordinance that the provisions of (c) of this section
11 do not apply in the political subdivision when elections are being
12 held. The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall adopt regulations
13 governing the sale of intoxicating liquor on election days in the
14 unorganized areas of the state.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 04.10.430 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (c) If the petition for a local option election is for a community
17 liquor license under sec. 139 of this chapter, the board is precluded
18 from issuing additional new licenses of any other type within the
19 boundaries of the city or town opting for the community liquor license.
20 This section does not affect the provisions of AS 04.10.260 or liquor
21 licenses issued before the effective date of this section.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 04.10.190(a)(5) is repealed.

23 * Sec. 4. Sec. 3 of this Act is retrospective to May 26, 1971.
