6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to electrical safety; and providing  
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.60.580 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 18.60.580. MINIMUM ELECTRICAL STANDARDS. The Department of  
11 Labor shall adopt the 1971 [1968] published edition of the National  
12 Electrical Code approved by the American Standards Association, and  
13 the latest published edition as of August 5, 1969 of the National  
14 Electrical Safety Code issued by the U. S. Department of Commerce,  
15 Bureau of Standards, as the minimum electrical safety standards of the  
16 state.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 18.60.590(a) is amended to read:

18 (a) The department may by regulation adopt amendments to the  
19 1971 [1968] National Electrical Code as approved and issued by the  
20 American Standards Association.

21 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
22 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
