6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to declarations of candidacy for
7 district-wide office; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 15.25.040(c) is amended to read:

11 (c) A candidate for state-wide offices shall file with the
12 lieutenant governor. A candidate for district-wide office shall file
13 either with a clerk of the superior court [IN THE SENATE DISTRICT
14 OF WHICH THE CANDIDATE IS A RESIDENT] or the lieutenant governor. [IF
15 A CANDIDATE FOR DISTRICT-WIDE OFFICE FILES A DECLARATION WITH THE
16 LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR SHALL IMMEDIATELY, BY
17 TELEPHONE TO BE FOLLOWED BY LETTER, NOTIFY THE APPROPRIATE CLERK OF
18 THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE FILING.] If the candidate files his
19 declaration with the clerk of the superior court, the clerk shall
20 immediately forward the declaration to the lieutenant governor.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
22 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
