6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the discretionary suspension,  
7 revocation or limitation of motor vehicle operators'  
8 licenses,"

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 28.15.220(b) is amended to read:

11 (b) A court may as a part of the sentence for conviction of a  
12 violation of a state statute [ANY LAW OR ORDINANCE] regulating the  
13 operation of motor vehicles upon a highway or upon complaint of the  
14 department revoke, suspend, or limit a license, upon a showing by the  
15 department that the licensee

16 (1) has committed an offense for which mandatory revocation  
17 of license is required upon conviction;

18 (2) was responsible as a driver for causing an accident  
19 resulting in the death or personal injury of another or a serious  
20 property damage;

21 (3) has been convicted with such frequency of serious of-  
22 fenses against traffic regulations governing the movement of vehicles  
23 as to indicate a disrespect for traffic laws and a disregard for the  
24 safety of other persons on the highways;

25 (4) is an habitually reckless or negligent driver of a  
26 motor vehicle;

27 (5) is incompetent to drive a motor vehicle;

28 (6) permitted an unlawful or fraudulent use of his license;

29 (7) committed an offense in another state which, if committed

1 in this state, would be grounds for suspension or revocation;

2 (8) has operated a motor vehicle in violation of a limita-  
3 tion placed on his license during the period of limitation.
