6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the accessibility and usability of
7 buildings and facilities at the campuses and community
8 colleges of the University of Alaska by physically
9 handicapped students; and providing for an effective
10 date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 35.10.015 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 35.10.015. ARCHITECTURAL BARRIER REGULATIONS. The Depart-
14 ment of Public Works is responsible for preparing and promulgating
15 regulations governing the construction of public buildings and facili-
16 ties by or for the state, including the University of Alaska, and its
17 political subdivisions to insure that the public buildings and
18 facilities are accessible to, and usable by, the physically handi-
19 capped. The regulations of the department shall conform as far as it
20 is feasible to the publication entitled "American Standard Specifica-
21 tions for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by
22 the Physically Handicapped" or any amendments to this publication as
23 approved by the American Standards Association, Incorporated, under the
24 sponsorship of the National Society for Crippled Children and Adults
25 and the President's Committee on Employment of the Physically
26 Handicapped.

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
