6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the legal school age for certain
7 children."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA;

9 * Section 1. AS 14.03.070 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 14.03.070. SCHOOL AGE. A child who is six years of age or
11 who will become six years of age before November 2 following the
12 beginning of the school year, and who is under the age of 20 and has
13 not completed the 12th grade, is of school age. However, a child who
14 is mentally retarded, physically or emotionally handicapped or who
15 has learning disabilities is of school age from the time of his birth.
