6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sex discrimination."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 18.80.210 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 18.80.210. CIVIL RIGHTS. The opportunity to obtain employ-  
10 ment, public accommodations, housing accommodations and property without  
11 discrimination because of sex, race, religion, color, or national  
12 origin is a civil right.

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 18.80.220(2) is amended to read:

14 (2) a labor organization, because of a person's sex, age,  
15 race, religion, color or national origin, to exclude or to expel him from  
16 its membership, or to discriminate in any way against one of its  
17 members or an employer or an employee;

19 (3) an employer or employment agency to print or circulate

29 TION. It is unlawful for the owner, lessee, manager, agent or employee

2 (1) to refuse, withhold from or deny to a person any of its  
3 services, goods, facilities, advantages or privileges because of sex,  
4 race, religion, color or national origin;

5 (2) to publish, circulate, issue, display, post or mail a  
6 written or printed communication, notice or advertisement which states  
7 or implies that any of the services, goods, facilities, advantages or  
8 privileges of the public accommodation will be refused, withheld from  
9 or denied to a person of a certain race, religion, sex, color or  
10 national origin or that the patronage of a person belonging to a  
11 particular race, creed, sex, color or national origin is unwelcome,  
12 not desired or solicited.

14 Sec. 18.80.240. UNLAWFUL PRACTICES IN THE SALE OR RENTAL OF  
15 PROPERTY OR HOUSING ACCOMMODATIONS. It is unlawful for the owner,  
16 lessee, manager or other person having the right to sell, lease or rent  
17 a housing accommodation or unimproved property

18 (1) to refuse to sell, lease or rent the housing accommoda-  
19 tion or unimproved property to a person because of sex, race, religion,  
20 color or national origin;

21 (2) to discriminate against a person because of sex, race,  
22 religion, color or national origin in a term, condition or privilege  
23 relating to the use, sale, lease or rental of a housing accommodation  
24 or unimproved property; or

25 (3) to make a written or oral inquiry or record of the sex,  
26 race, religion, color or national origin of a person seeking to buy,  
27 lease or rent a housing accommodation or unimproved property.

1 a financial institution, upon receiving an application for financial  
2 assistance for the acquisition, construction, rehabilitation, repair  
3 or maintenance of a housing accommodation or the acquisition or improve-  
4 ment of unimproved property, to permit one of its officials or employees  
5 during the execution of his duties

6 (1) to discriminate against the applicant because of sex,  
7 race, religion, color or national origin in a term, condition or  
8 privilege relating to the obtainment or use of the institution's  
9 financial assistance; or

10 (2) to make or cause to be made a written or oral inquiry  
11 or record of the sex, race, religion, color or national origin of a  
12 person seeking the institution's financial assistance.

14 Sec. 18.80.255. UNLAWFUL PRACTICES BY THE STATE OR ITS POLITICAL  
15 SUBDIVISIONS. It is unlawful for the state or any of its political  
16 subdivisions

17 (1) to refuse, withhold from or deny to a person any local,  
18 state or federal funds, services, goods, facilities, advantages or  
19 privileges because of race, religion, sex, color or national origin;

20 (2) to publish, circulate, issue, display, post or mail a  
21 written or printed communication, notice or advertisement which states  
22 or implies that any local, state or federal funds, services, goods,  
23 facilities, advantages or privileges of the office or agency will be  
24 refused, withheld from or denied to a person of a certain race, reli-  
25 gion, sex, color or national origin or that the patronage of a person  
26 belonging to a particular race, creed, sex, color or national origin  
27 is unwelcome, not desired or solicited.
