* Section 1. AS 21.27.510(a) is amended to read:

(a) "Adjuster" means a person who, for compensation as an inde-

pendent contractor or as an employee of an independent contractor, or

11

for fee or commission, investigates and adjusts claims arising under

12

insurance contracts on behalf of the insurer. An attorney at law

13

who adjusts insurance losses from time to time incidental to the

14

practice of his profession [, OR AN ADJUSTER OF MARINE LOSSES], or a

15

salaried employee of an insurer or of a general agent is not considered

16

to be an adjuster for the purposes of this chapter.
