5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to public education powers; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 07.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 07.12.070. LIMIT ON EDUCATION POWER. The limitation on
11 areawide powers of education applicable to first and second class
12 boroughs under AS 07.15.330 in areas constituting military reservations
13 applies to home rule boroughs.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 07.15.330(a) is amended to read:

15 (a) Each organized borough constitutes a borough school district
16 and the first and second class borough shall establish, maintain, and
17 operate a system of public schools on an areawide basis. This areawide
18 power of education may not be exercised in an area constituting a
19 military reservation until the military reservation status is ter-
20 minated unless exercise of the power is approved by the Department of
21 Education.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 07.17.020(a) is amended to read:

23 (a) A third class borough shall exercise the areawide powers of
24 education and tax assessment and collection as provided for second
25 class boroughs in this title. The areawide power of education may not
26 be exercised in an area constituting a military reservation until the
27 military reservation status is terminated unless exercise of the power
28 is approved by the Department of Education.

29 * Sec. 4. AS 14.12.020(a) is amended to read:

1 (a) Operation of the state-operated school district is under the
2 management and control of the board of the state-operated schools.
3 Management and control under this subsection extends to those schools
4 located in organized boroughs or cities in areas constituting military
5 reservations until the military reservation status is terminated unless
6 exercise of the power is approved by the Department of Education.

7 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
8 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
