6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to public education; and providing
7 for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.03.080(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A child of school age is entitled to attend public school
11 without payment of tuition during the school term in the school district
12 in which he is a resident subject to the provisions of AS 14.14.110 and
13 AS 14.14.120. [THIS SUBSECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO WAIVE
14 COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS OF AS 14.30.010.]

15 * Sec. 2. AS 14.14.110 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 14.14.110. COOPERATION WITH OTHER DISTRICTS. When necessary
17 to provide more efficient or more economical educational services, a
18 district may cooperate or the department may require a district to
19 cooperate with other districts, state-operated schools, or the Bureau
20 of Indian Affairs in providing educational services or in establishing
21 boarding and tuition arrangements, arrangements for the exchange of
22 pupils or teachers, or other similar arrangements. However, if a
23 cooperative arrangement requires pupils to live away from their usual
24 homes, the school board shall provide classes within the attendance area
25 when there are at least eight children eligible to attend elementary
26 and secondary school in the attendance area [DISTRICT FOR ANY GRADE
27 REPRESENTED BY MORE THAN THREE ELEMENTARY PUPILS OR FIVE SECONDARY
28 PUPILS].

29 * Sec 3. AS 14.60.010 is amended by adding a new section to read:

1 (9) "attendance area" means the geographic area designated
2 by the department to be served by a school.

3 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1972.
