6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility requirements for the
7 executive officer of the Board of Nursing."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.68.111(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The executive officer shall be a nurse having a bachelor's
11 degree or higher, currently licensed in the state and with not less
12 than five years of active nursing experience, of which not less than
13 two years within the preceding five years shall have been in an admin-
14 istrative or a teaching capacity in an accredited institution acceptable
15 to the board. If a licensed, registered nurse with a bachelor's degree
16 is not available, the board may waive the requirement for a bachelor's
17 degree if the licensed, registered nurse possesses other qualifications
18 which the board considers acceptable.
