6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to deviate sexual intercourse by  
7 force or imposition."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 11.15.135. DEVIATE SEXUAL INTERCOURSE BY FORCE OR IMPOSI-  
11 TION. (a) A person who engages in deviate sexual intercourse with  
12 another person, or who causes another to engage in deviate sexual  
13 intercourse, commits deviate sexual intercourse by force if

14 (1) he compels the other person to participate by force or  
15 by threat of imminent death, serious bodily harm, extreme pain, or  
16 kidnapping, to be inflicted on anyone; or

17 (2) he has substantially impaired the other person's power  
18 to appraise or control his conduct, by administering or employing  
19 without the knowledge of the other person a drug, intoxicant or other  
20 means f o r the purpose of preventing resistance; or

21 (3) the other person is unconscious; or

22 (4) the other person is less than 14 years old.

23 (b) A person convicted of deviate sexual intercourse by force is  
24 punishable by imprisonment in the penitentiary for not more than 20  
25 years.

26 (c) A person who engages in deviate sexual intercourse with  
27 another person, or who causes another to engage in deviate sexual  
28 intercourse, commits deviate sexual intercourse by imposition if

29 (1) he compels the other person to participate by a threat

1 less than those under (a)(1) of this section, but of sufficient conse-  
2 quence reasonably calculated to prevent resistance; or

3 (2) he knows or reasonably should know that the other person  
4 suffers from a mental disease or defect which renders him incapable  
5 of appraising the nature of his conduct; or

6 (3) he knows or reasonably should know that the other person  
7 submits because he is unaware that a sexual act is being committed  
8 upon him.

9 (d) A person convicted of deviate sexual intercourse by imposition  
10 is punishable by imprisonment in the penitentiary for not more than 10  
11 years.

12 (e) In this section, "deviate sexual intercourse" means sexual  
13 gratification between human beings who are not husband and wife, involv-  
14 ing contact of the genital organs of one and the mouth or anus of another,  
15 and any form of sexual intercourse with an animal.
